This Cookie Policy describes what cookies are and how we use them on our Website. What are cookies

A cookie is a piece of software code that an internet website sends to your browser when you access information at that site. A cookie is stored as a simple text file on your computer or mobile device by a website's server, and only that server will be able to retrieve or read the contents of that cookie. Cookies let you navigate between pages efficiently as they store your preferences, and generally improve your experience of a website.

What type of Cookies do we use?

Essential Cookies

Necessary for the website to function properly—for example, enabling secure logins and core navigation.

Performance & Analytics Cookies

Help us understand how visitors use our site, so we can improve functionality and content. Data collected is aggregated and anonymous.

Functional Cookies

Store your preferences (such as language settings) to provide a more personalized experience.

Cookies enable us to understand how you use the Website and enhance your experience whilst on it. In addition, they help us to provide you with a better Website by enabling us to monitor which pages you find helpful and those you do not. Please be assured that cookies do not give us access to your computer or any information about you other than the data you choose to share with us. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may be unable to use some portions of our Website.
